

YMCA National Swimming & Diving Championships
Fort Lauderdale, Florida
April 7-10, 2010

During this year's YMCA Short Course Nationals, the West End of the Spectator Grandstands (directly in front of the diving well) will be closed at the Ft Lauderdale Aquatics Center.

If additional spectator seat is necessary for any prelim session, a set of bleachers will be available on deck between the Girls pool and the diving well for overflow seating.

Spectators will be able to view the Girls prelim swims, but viewing of the boys pool most likely will be obstructed. Therefore this seating should be used for spectators who want to watch Girls preliminary session swimming

If the on-deck seating is required, spectators must abide by several pool rules

- Seating will be available on a first come, first served basis
- On-deck spectators will need to wear a wrist bracelet to identify them as being permitted to be in the on-deck bleacher area
- Saving of seats is not be allowed and will be strictly enforced
- Entrance to the on-deck bleacher will be through the swimmers/coaches entrance on the far west side of the pool (between the grandstand and the concession area)
- Spectators are not allowed to access any other part of the deck including locker rooms or the surrounding pool deck areas. (Spectator bathrooms are located in the main grandstands by the front entrance gate)
- Any spectator found in an authorized area of the pool will be asked to leave the deck seating area
- As is always the case, no flash photograph is permitted at the start of the any of the races
