His many accomplishments and great influence in this program led to the creation of the Joseph G. Rogers Award. This award is the most prestigious award in YMCA competitive aquatics and is housed in the International Swimming Hall of Fame located in Ft. Lauderdale. Florida.

Ronald Gora (University of Michigan) and **Gaither Rosser** (still researching) who were participants in this meet continued there swimming careers in college and both became members of the 1952 U.S. Olympic Team. **Ron** was a member of the NCAA National Championship Relay Teams in 1953 and 1954 at Michigan. member of the 1951 Gold Medal Pan American Games 800 Meter Freestyle Relay Team with Dick Cleveland, Burwell Jones and Bill Heusner.
