[Don was a swimmer in the 1951 National Championship meet held in Chicago, Illinois as a representative of the Colorado Spring YMCA and placed second in both 220 Yard Free Style and 150 Yard Individual Medley events.]

Notes of Historical Interest: John Dilley (father) and Gary Dilley (son) from the Huntington, Indiana participated in this YMCA Championship Meet. John started swimming for the Huntington YMCA in 1939 until the war years and returned to swim with the Huntington Y again in 1946. His last National Y Meet was in 1959. Gary's first Y Nationals was in 1959 and he continued until 1963. Gary then continued swimming with the Michigan State Spartans. In 1964, Gary represented the United States in the 1964 Olympic Games in Tokyo, Japan winning the Silver Medal in the 100 Meter Backstroke.

Past National YMCA champions that were also members of the 1964 U.S. Olympic Team were: Tom Gompf (1 and 3 Meter Diving) from the Central Branch YMCA in Dayton, Ohio and Chet Jastremski (100 & 200 Yard Butterfly and the 200 Yd. Individual Medley) from the Central Branch YMCA in Toledo, Ohio. Tom won the Bronze Medal in the 10 Meter Platform Diving and Chet won the Bronze Medal in the 200 Meter Breaststroke.
