

YMCA MASTERS NATIONAL SWIMMING MEET April 15 - 18, 2010

Approved and hosted by the YMCA National Swimming and Diving Advisory Committee. Recognized by Florida Gold Coast for United States Masters Swimming, Inc

MEET FACILITY	 Conducted at the Fort Lauderdale Aquatic Complex, Fort Lauderdale, Florida. The facility consists of: Two identical eight-lane, 25 yard pools. A separate warm-up / warm-down pool available throughout the meet. Colorado Timing System will be used as the primary time, with a backup and a watch time on each lane. 		
RULES	Current "Rules That Govern YMCA Competitive Sports" will prevail. Current USMS technical rules will prevail unless otherwise noted in this meet information.		
DISABILITY	Swimmers with hearing or sight concerns should confer with the starter/referee prior to their events in order that assistance may be provided. Swimmers with physical disabilities may assume a starting position prior to other participants in a heat.		
ELIGIBILITY See separate eligibility statement	A swimmer must be an amateur athlete in the competitive season in swimming and be age 18 or older on the last day of the meet. All swimmers are strongly encouraged to have a physical examination/medical evaluation prior to competing in the meet.		
CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE	YMCA TEAMS THAT DO NOT COMPLY WITH THIS REQUIREMENT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM AT THE MEET.		
Critical Item Check the website for correct wording.	Each team, consisting of one or more individuals, must submit a "Certificate of Liability Insurance" from their YMCA in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000. The certificate must name the YMCA of the USA as the Certificate Holder (see sample). The "Certificate of Liability Insurance" must be sent directly to the YMCA of the USA as soon as possible, but no later than March 31, 2010. EVENTS	All events will be swum in two pools with odd-numbered heats in one pool and even- numbered heats in the other pool.
	All events will be pre-seeded, by age group and then by time, slowest to fastest, except for the 500 Free, 1000 Free, 1650 Free, and 400 IM which will be seeded by time, slowest to fastest
INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES	A swimmer may enter no more than three (3) individual events per day, and no more than eight (8) individual events for the entire meet.
	A swimmer's age group is determined by that swimmer's age on the last day of the meet, April 19, 2010. Age groups to be contested are as follows: 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94, 95-99, and 100+.
	There are no qualifying time standards for this meet. A swimmer should enter his/her best achieved time for each event entered. An entry time of " NO TIME " will NOT be accepted.
	A swimmer interested in USMS records must submit A current USMS membership number
RELAY ENTRIES	Swimmers entered into relays but not swimming individual events must have their names listed on the team roster and must submit individual entry forms with appropriate fees paid.
Unlimited Relay Entries	Swimmers are not permitted to swim on more than 5 relays (one 200 freestyle relay, one 200 medley relay, one 200 mixed freestyle relay, one 200 mixed medley relay, or one 400 freestyle relay per event).
	Relay age groups are determined by the age of the youngest swimmer on the relay. Age groups for relays are as follows: 18+, 25+, 35+, 45+, 55+, 65+, 75+, and 85+.
	Associations may enter unlimited relays per age group in each women's and each men's relay event, and unlimited relays in each mixed relay event. Only swimmers listed on the team's roster will be eligible to swim on the team's relays.
	Women's relays must consist of four women. Men's relays must consist of four men. Mixed relays may be made up of two women and two men, or three women and one man.
	Once a relay team has been entered, the relay will be seeded at the time entered. "NO TIME" entries will NOT be accepted. The times of the four swimmers may be combined for relay entry times.
	Relay cards should be submitted to the scoring room the day prior to the event. If necessary, changes to the relay may be made before the event is swum.
	NOTE: Relay times at this meet can be considered for USMS Records and Top Ten Times, provided that all four members of the relay team are registered on the same USMS registered club.
