▶ Meet Attire for Swim Officials & Timers:

Preliminaries (Morning Sessions)

- White shorts or skirts, no shorter than 4" above knee.
- Shirt will be provided.

Finals (Evening Sessions)

- <u>Must</u> wear long white pants and white shirt/blouse. Certified YMCA swim officials must wear their officials' patch.
- No shorts or skirts.

> Swim Official Certification/Recertification & Trainer Certification Courses:

A Level 2 Swim Officials Certification/Recertification Course will be offered on Tuesday, April 6. A Swim Officials Trainers Certification Course will be offered on Tuesday, April 6. Please note the prerequisites for this clinic have changed and applications are due to YMCA of the USA at least two weeks before the clinic.

> Time Trials

Each day after the preliminary session we will hold Time Trials. We will continue giving the officials the ability to volunteer pre-meet to work Time Trials as well as recruiting at the morning Pre-Meet Meeting.

This is an opportunity to be mentored and get noticed/recognized as possible future starters, referees and head officials for upcoming national meets. Everyone who wants to try being a starter or referee will be given the opportunity.

▶ Food and Beverages

Each morning before and during the meeting, bagels, doughnuts, dry cereal, fruits and beverages will be available for those officials working at that session in the meeting room. There will also be water available there throughout the day.

Lunch will be served, for those who worked that session, immediately following the end of the Preliminaries; various local restaurants like Olive Garden, Outback, etc. usually cater it.

Snacks and beverages will be available during the meeting before Finals.

> Travel, Lodging, Parking,

Costs for travel and lodging for the meet are the responsibility of the individual volunteer.

If you are driving to the Pool, you will have to pay to park in a public facility and pay the fees: free parking is not provided, as parking at the Pool itself is very limited.

> Admission, Access to Pool Deck, Watching Your Child Swim

As a volunteer/official, you receive free admission and access to the Pool Deck <u>for those sessions</u> <u>you are working.</u>

We realize that the primary reason most of you are at this meet is to support your child. We will make sure that you will be able to watch them swim. At Preliminaries for the four days the male swimmers will swim in the East Course and female swimmers will swim in the West Course, we will try to accommodate those wanting to switch pools to see their child. In the event that all requests cannot be accommodated, we will make sure that for an individual heat we will find a replacement for you.
