#### Benefits to Stay at approved HOTELS <u>Commitment to help keep the</u> <u>Swim Nationals affordable FOR</u>

ALL. Event expenses have risen significantly in some areas, yet over the past 3 years registration fees have only increased **by approximately 3%**. This has been intentional. The ability to capture financial incentives through hotel partnerships allows us to make our Championships better, keep costs in line and secures the future of this event.

#### Event Volume Muscle.
