As a part of your course you will aid in teaching the Swim Official Level II Class Monday 11:30 AM to 3:30 PM. You will receive assignments via email. Block out your day from 8:00 AM to 3:30 PM. (You will have a break from 10:00 AM to 11:30 AM)

You must provide your own current USA Swimming Rule book.

Cost: **\$25 Trainer Course(Make checks payable to YMCA of the USA --- Bring to class.)**

Purpose: To certify participants as trainers for YMCA Swim Officials I and YMCA Swim Official II

Prerequisites:

1. Must have been certified as a YMCA Level II Official for more than three years (i.e., attended at least one re-certification clinic)
2. Must have worked as a YMCA Certified Official at a minimum of fifteen meet sessions over the past three years, with at least eight of those sessions being as a Referee or Starter
3. Must have worked at his/her local YMCA State/District/Zone/Regional/ Championship Meet as a deck official for at least two years encompassing six meet sessions. Please include a short bio indicating the championship meets that you have worked and the position that you have filled.

If you meet the above criteria follow the steps below

4. Complete the National Trainer Application and sent it to Y-USA Events Registration at least three weeks prior to the Trainer Clinic (for this year March 14, 2011)
5. Complete the Record of Meet Experience and submit with your application. Include a short bio indicating the championship meets that you have worked and the positions that you have filled.
6. Complete the required prerequisite YMCA Courses
 - o Orientation to the YMCA Training Systems – Must be done online prior to this course – go to www.ymcaexchange.org.
 - o Adult Learning Concepts – Must be taken online prior to this course – go to www.ymcaexchange.org.
7. Obtain a recommendation from his/her local YMCA CEO, Aquatic Director or Full-time YMCA Employee Coach and a National Officials' Committee Member.
8. Must be approved by the YMCA of the USA Director for National Events and the National Officials' Committee Chair (Events Registration will forward the Applications for these approvals)

Candidates must complete the trainer candidate application as posted on the web site.
