## Volunteer Photographer Instructions

- You must register at one of the following Meet Registration sessions to receive your credentials before you will be allowed on the pool deck.
  - We are looking for photographs that tell the story of what happens before and during the meet.
  - Please only be on deck during your assigned day
  - Please plan on working the entire day. This will include morning warm-ups, athlete and spectator entrances, prelims, time trials, and finals including all award ceremonies. On the last day of the meet, this will also include working through the Team Awards following finals.
  - Most of all – be considerate – of officials, coaches, athletes, parents, other photographers – everyone
  - No flash photography on starts – possible during competition. You need to listen to the announcer or check with the help desk
  - Three photographers will be assigned to each day. There will be a daily 8:00 a.m. Photographers Meeting in the Technology Room (Computer room) for the photographers assigned for that day. You will meet the other photographers assigned to that day and be given any additional instructions. Please coordinate with the other photographers to make sure that everything is being covered.

- We absolutely need photos of the following events:
    - Pre-meet events such as registration and Athletes' Welcome Party
    - ALL Devotions before Prelims
    - ALL Devotions and National Anthem performance before Finals
    - ALL Color Guard and Water Banner swimmers before Finals
    - **All** award presentations
    - Any special speakers we may have
  - We need photos of everything going on at the meet
    - Swimming
    - Coaches
    - Officials
    - Spectators
    - Vendors
    - Hospitality
    - Officials' Meetings
    - Give a broad picture of what's happening during the meet.

- When your session is over, bring your camera or memory card to the computer room so we can download your photos. We will pick the photos that will be used on the website. All photos may be used by YMCA of the USA as they need.
  - Photographs taken may not be sold
  - Photographs may only be taken in public areas. Any area where there is an expectation of privacy is off limits to photography.
