# 12<sup>th</sup> International Y.M.C.A. Swimming and Diving Championship - April 20-21

### Hosted by the Downtown Branch YMCA of St. Louis, Missouri

The meet was held at the Wilson Pool at Washington University in St. Louis, Missouri. There were 14 YMCA Associations and 82 participants that took part in this year's International Y.M.C.A. Swimming and Diving Championships. The officiating staff was headed up by Arthur E. Eilers of Washington University and a member of the Intercollegiate Rules Committee who was the meet referee. A total of 34 officials were used to run the meet.
