**<u>Historical Notes:</u>** There were 27 YMCA Associations and 117 entrants that took part in this championship meet. To the best of my knowledge this is the 1<sup>st</sup> National Meet to have a Queen. The Queen was <u>Mary Freeman</u>, a 17 year-old from Washington D.C., who was favored to win a birth on the 1952 Women's USA Olympic Team. Mary at the time was the defending national champion in the 100 and 200 Meter Backstroke events. **Mary did become a member of the 1952 Women's U.S. Olympic Team. Special Note:** The Referee for this meet was <u>Matt Mann</u>, coach for the University of Michigan, who became the Swimming Coach for the 1952 U.S. Olympic Team.
