**Biography:** Donald Leas, a participant in this meet, was the 2007 Recipient of the Joseph G. Rogers Award. Don was an all around athlete not only in swimming and diving but also track and field, cross country and gymnastics. He was the Captain of the Michigan State Gymnastic Team and was the Big 10 Champion on the Flying Rings. Don was the Diving Referee at the National YMCA Swimming and Diving Championships for many years.

### 26<sup>th</sup> National YMCA Swimming and Diving information continued:

<u>Biographical Notes:</u> Don Brown, who won the 100 yard Backstroke event and set a New National Record in the 200 yard Backstroke at this meet, continued his outstanding swimming career at the University of Denver. In 1959, Don who was the Swimming Coach at Colorado Springs High School, was instrumental in hosting our National YMCA Swimming and Diving Championships in Colorado Springs on April 9-11. At this meet, Don Brown was the Chairman of Officials and the meet announcer. He also served on the Championship Committee along with Charles McCaffree(+) (Michigan State University Swimming Coach) and Robert Golay(+) (Executive Director of the Tucson Arizona YMCA).

**Robin C. Moore** (Phoenix, AZ) and **Richard Fadgen** (Woonsocket, RI), swimmers in this meet, exchanged 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places in the 100 and 200 yard Breaststroke Events—Robin winning the 100 and Richard the 200. Both of these young men went on to have great college careers -- Robin at Stanford University and Richard at North Carolina State. In 1956, at the NCAA Swimming and Diving Championship held at Yale University, Robin won the 50 Yard Freestyle (22.1) and Richard won both the 200 Yard Breaststroke (2:23.1) and the 200 Yard Butterfly (2:16.3). In addition, Richard participated in the 1952 & 1954 National Y Championships and was a member of the 1956 United States Olympic Swimming Team.
