The Individuals <u>High Point Award</u> winner was **Dave Kondracke** from the Springfield, Ohio YMCA. Dave scored 18 points with (2) 1st places in the 220 and 440 Yard Freestyle and 3rd in the 200 Yard Individual Medley. Close behind Dave were Virgil Luken and John Bergman from Minneapolis, MN with 17 ½ points.

Coach Glenn Hummer, of the Huntington YMCA Swimming and Diving Team since the mid-1930's, won his 4th National Y Championship Meet this year in Dayton, Ohio. The other years his teams won were in 1940, 1946 and 1957.

<u>Historical Note:</u> The Announcer for the meet <u>Ted Brick</u> was a National YMCA Swimmer who represented the Brooklyn New York YMCA from 1929 thru 1937. In 1929, his team won the National YMCA Championship held at George Williams College in Chicago, Illinois.

<u>U. S. Olympic Team:</u> To the best of my knowledge and research, 2 participants from this meet represented the United States in the 1964 Olympics in Tokyo, Japan.

- 1. Virgil Luken from the Minneapolis, MN, was a member of the 400 Meter Medley Relay
- 2. Gary Dilley from Huntington, IN won the Silver Medal in the 100 Meter Backstroke.
